Low Ropes The Low Ropes Course is an obstacle course designed to have groups work together to achieve one purpose. Professionally certified instructors present challenging problems that require the group to cooperate with each other to achieve much more than they would have been able to do alone.

Payment

A minimum of 25% of camp fee is due at time of registration. Concession fees are optional and may be entered at the time of registration or may be ignored by placing a "0" in the concession box at check-out.
